June Speaker Recap

Our June 20th meeting was very eye opening. The speaker Don Barnett from the Center for Immigration Studies shared much information about the status of immigration in the United States. Here is what you should know.

Mr. Barnett shared a video from McGowan Airport of refugees being sent to various cities in the U.S. It showed lots of families and individuals who were given free airfare but came in with no luggage or food. The same main countries come into United States sending refugees: Democratic Republic of Congo, Ukraine, and Burma. President Trump brought down the number of refugee resettlements a great deal but President Biden has brought it up. In Tennessee, Nashville gets the most in resettlement refugees. Refugees are eligible for the same amount of welfare as a U.S. citizen.

Family separation first occurred during the Obama era. Children as young as three years old are dropped over the border by coyotes of the cartel. Some walls are 20 feet high and they are still being climbed and crossed. If an un-accompanied minor, they will be taken in. In 2022 Tennessee got nearly 5,000 un-accompanied minors. The people say they are minors. We do not know if they are or not. Some are being trafficked but we do not know how many. Guatemala sends the most unaccompanied minors. Only 42% go to a parent when they arrive here. 13% are going into our foster care system. Many gang members entered during the Trump administration. 150, 000 unaccompanied children under the age of 18 were sent across the border in 2022. In 2022, 2.7 million crossed the border. This does not include got aways. These do not get welfare. The got-aways at least number 400,000 a year. In 2021 Tennessee spent 143.7 million on English Language Learners. TB being brought into the country is a real concern. People are not being tested. The cartel is controlling the border better than border control.

Maddening, isn't it?

August Speaker Recap

Our August speaker was United States Representative Scott DeJarlais. We had in attendance 45 members, visitors, and guests at the Carriage Lane Inn on August 15, 2023. Dr. DeJarlais had a busy night and was speaking at three different functions. At our meeting he talked about how the immigrant population is out of control in our country. He feels strongly that we must care for our citizens first rather than immigrants first. He shared his experiences as he traveled to bases in Australia, Alaska, Vietnam, Singapore and other places, which led to him saying that we need to be prepared for a great conflict between China and Taiwan. He also encouraged women to make sure their voice was heard in the next election. He said women make the decisions regarding health and education. We need to use these as our platform to decide who the best candidates are. Members were encouraged to ask Representative DeJarlais questions. There were many different ones that were asked. Such things as supporting Rand Paul as he tries to get to the bottom of the mess that occurred during covid and Dr. Fauci's role in it. Why President Trump is being persecuted and what is being done to stop it? And how can we better honor our Veterans were just a few of the well informed questions our audience asked. As always it was a delight to be at a RWRC meeting. Come to the next one. You don't know what you are missing.
