February Speaker Recap

Loren Spivack was the speaker for the Republican Women of Rutherford County's (RWRC) February 2023 meeting held on February 21st, 2023 at Carriage Lane Inn. His topic was Free Market Economics. I had heard at the Tennessee Federation of Republican Women (TFRW) Board of Director's Meeting that he was a great speaker and everyone should invite him to their club to speak. He lived up to his reputation.

Mr. Spivack spoke about the inequities that exist in the United States from racially segregated dormitories to women being driven out of their own sports. The problem is the Left is wanting to control every part of your life. Spivack said they daydream about what your life should be like under socialism.

Spivack laid out three principles at stake:

- 1. Freedom of Speech- He quoted New York Times which said "To save our democracy freedom of speech has to go." Spivack said that freedom of speech is dead in every country except in the United States.
- 2. Justice in the United States- He said that the Left does not believe in impartial justice.
- 3. Capitalism- There is a constant fight between Capitalism and Socialism.

Mr. Spivak then told about his 5 books he had for sale and led a great question and answer session.

Board of Directors' Meeting

Hillwood Country Club in Nashville on February 11, 2023

The meeting was a great experience for me and something I would love to repeat. I met many wonderful women decked in their red clothing.

The Federation ended last year with 47 clubs and 140 new members in it.

I enjoyed the Area Vice President's Reports where each Vice President shared things that their clubs were doing to encourage membership and present the Republican agenda. Ideas were a chili contest and speaker raising funds for the Isaiah House; participating in their local parade; formal teas, and debates of candidates.

Senator Majority Leader Jack Johnson then shared information about the Bills being discussed concerning youth gender reassignment and children attending drag shows in public venues like public libraries. He entertained questions afterwards that focused on the Governor's State of the State Address. It was a very interesting Q and A.

After an earlier vote, the TFRW presented Senator Johnson a resolution stating that we affirmed our belief that gender reassignment surgery in children was not appropriate.

Finally, we ended with information about the TFRW Convention. The theme is Pickwick Republican River Run. The Ladies in Red Take Over Pickwick. Watch for more information and I encourage everyone to attend the Ladies Day on the Hill on March 27th.
