

August 1, 2024 is Murfreesboro's general election to elect its mayor and city council AND Tennessee's Primary election to elect its state house and state senate seats. Voter Registration Deadline -- July 2, 2024

Early Voting -- Friday, July 12 - Saturday, July 27, 2024

Lara Trump and The Republican National Convention recommend "Bank your vote: Vote early" to help prevent voter fraud.

Absentee Ballot Request Deadline -- Thursday, July 25, 2024

****You can vote at any polling location in Rutherford County.

Visit <u>Voter - Rutherford County, TN (rutherfordcountytn.gov)</u> for sample ballot, absentee voting information, early voting information and more.

NOTE: Shawn Wright and Matt Herriman are the only candidates with a 100% Republican voting record. You do not HAVE to vote for three although the ballot gives the opportunity to vote for three. Let's get these two strong republicans on our council.

November 5, 2024 is U.S. ELECTION DAY for the following:

- 1.U.S. House, U.S. Senate, and U.S. Presidential general elections AND
- 2. Tennessee State general elections for the Tennessee House and Tennessee Senate.

POLITICAL AND CAMPAIGN HOURS

RWRC WILL FOLLOW THE BELOW REMINDERS FROM THE TENNESSEE FEDERATION OF REPUBLICAN WOMEN (TNFRW) ON RECORDING VOLUNTEER HOURS:

The deadline to record volunteer hours from the First Reporting Period, July 1, 2023 - December 31, 2023, has been extended to **July 14, 2024**. **July 15, 2024** is the deadline for the Second Reporting Period for Volunteer Hours & Calls.

Examples of Volunteer Calls:

- Scheduling Meetings, Events, or Speakers
- Ballot Questions or Initiatives
- Calls to Action for Issues and/or Legislative Activities
- Campaign Calls
- Polling Calls

Political and Campaign Volunteer Hours Include (where applicable):

- 1. Travel time to and from the activity
- 2. Research and development of the activity (example: social media posts / letters to the editor)
- 3. Preparation and breakdown of activity

Hours collected are on a best estimate basis. Round up to the closest whole hour.

Primary and Associate member hours should be counted. When in doubt count the hour.

Examples of Volunteer Activities:

- Attending, preparing for, or volunteering at NRW club meetings, attending all Republican events such as Reagan Day Dinner, GOP Nashville monthly breakfasts, and Region, State, and National Federation meetings and conventions
- Running for office
- Serving on committees
- Working at a Local, County, State, National Republican office
- Working at a Local, County, State, National Republican candidate or elected official's office
- Working as an Election Officer, Poll Watcher, Challenger, or Election Integrity worker
- · Organizing, teaching, or attending a Campaign Management School
- All campaign activities benefiting our Republican Party, candidates, and/or the Federation
- Time spent making political and campaign calls

TNFRW PRIMARY SEASON RULES

Elections have a season and we are now in the primary season that will end on Election Day, Thursday, August 1.


On that day our candidates for state and federal office will be determined. That is when we set aside our personal preferences and get behind the Republicans who will be running for election on November 5, many with a Democrat opponent.

As a reminder, our clubs need to keep in mind the Bylaws regarding primaries:

- Our State Federation and clubs as a whole do not endorse in a primary.
- Our state and club presidents, campaign chairs and area vice presidents cannot endorse in a primary.
- Individual members may work for a candidate but not in the name of the club.
- Avoid posting candidates' information on the club's social media. It gives the impression that the club is endorsing.
- Be fair to invite all Republican candidates to speak at invited venues. Avoid inviting democratic and independent candidates. Remember, they are running against a republican.
- Clubs' databases are private and not to be shared with candidates or any other organization.
