JANUARY MEETING RECAP


President Karen Hudson introduced the Speaker for the evening of January 23, 2024 who was David Kiern.

POLITICAL AND CAMPAIGN HOURS

THE NATIONAL FEDERATION OF REPUBLICAN WOMEN (NFRW) REPORTS REPORTABLE VOLUNTEER HOURS EVERY 6 MONTHS.

The Republican Women of Rutherford County (RWRC) will follow the NFRW's plan.

Each (RWRC) member is to add their hours to the volunteer form (link below) every 6 months. Please track your time according to the below criteria.

Tips for recording political volunteer hours:

- When in doubt, count the time.
- Use your best estimate round up to the next whole hour.
- Count ALL volunteer hours UNLESS working in a salaried political position.
- Include travel time to and from meetings.
- Count time for research (social media, letters to the editor, etc.) and development of all political activities.

EXAMPLES OF ACTIVITIES:

- Time spent at and preparing for meetings/conventions in person or virtual.
- All campaign activities benefiting the Federation, Republican party, or Republican candidates.
- Attendance at all Republican events even if given a ticket.
- Running for office non-partisan or as a Republican candidate.
- Serving as an elected member on a campaign committee.
- All work or calls for any Republican campaign, election or Republican party office.
- All campaign activities benefitting the Republican party.
- Organizing or teaching a Campaign Management School.
- All other political and campaign activities.
